- We are governed by an elected Board of Directors. Section 12 of our Code of Regulations prohibits compensation for our Board members.
 Our Code of Regulations, Conflict of Interest Policy and Privacy Policy are public documents and available for viewing on our website.
- David F. Bolser, our CEO and Founder, is an Accredited Claims Agent with the Department of Veterans Affairs. His accreditation document may be viewed on our "About Us" page.
- Our services are provided <u>free</u> of charge. We serve seniors in all 50 states and provide them with 24/7 support for the <u>life</u> of their claim.
 We do not receive Federal, State or Local grants or financial assistance of any type. Our mission continues due to the generosity of our donors as well as merchandise sales.
- We are <u>not</u> Financial Planners, Attorneys or CPA's. We do <u>not</u> offer financial, legal or tax advice nor will we refer families to Financial Planners, Attorneys or CPA's. We will <u>not</u> act as a placement service for Home Care Agencies, Assisted-Living, Memory-Care or Senior Communities of any type.
- The Department of Veterans Affairs are the sole adjudicators of claims for Pension. We are neither employed by nor do we represent the Department of Veterans Affairs. As required by Federal statutes, we <u>do</u> use VA Accredited Claims Agents to assist with the claims process.

- The claimant is the one receiving the benefit from the VA. The
 veteran is the one whose service records are used to determine
 eligibility. The veteran and the claimant can be the same.
- Over 63% of those that apply for this benefit are widows. Over 90% are single, still own their home and live primarily from Social Security benefits. Around 85% of those that apply, receive care from family members. Over 60% of claimants receive care at home. The remaining 40% receive care from Assisted Living and Memory Care Communities or from private Home Care Agencies.
- It takes approximately 57 seconds for someone to answer the Eligibility Questions from our site and receive their complete VA Claim Application!
- Senior Veterans, Inc. helped over 18,000 families in 2013 and over 22,000 families in 2014. We provide 24/7 assistance for the life of the claim. All services are provided free regardless of the complexity of the claim.
